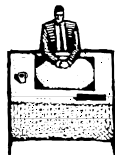

Looking into Fall

Hi everyone. Hope all of you had a great summer despite some trying weather. We have a very active schedule for the 2004-5 SCY season. Ithaca will be holding their annual Fall Meet on Nov 21. There will be meets in Syracuse, Canandaigua, and the NY State Championships in Binghamton this spring. Please consult the calendar in this and future WPG editions.

Swim against the Big Guys

Out of the district, the Colonies Zone SCM championships will be held at Wheaton Collage, MA Dec 4-5. The Colonies Zone SCY Championships will be held at George Mason Univ in Fairfax VA April 22-24. SCY Nationals are at the Hall of Fame Pool in Ft. Lauderdale FL May 19-22.

Word from Above

At the recently held USMS Convention in Orlando there were some major changes voted in by the delegates. The Board of Directors and the Executive Council are in the process of being reduced in number and reorganized to provide more efficient workings. A more noticeable change will be in our USMS Magazine, Swim. Effective in 2005, USMS will not be renewing the contract with Sports Publications Inc. The new publisher will be Douglas Murphy Communications Inc. DMC is a "contract publisher" specializing in not for profit organizations such as USMS.

Currently \$8.00 of our \$30 annual dues goes to Swim, which than rebates 3% of advertising revenues to USMS. Under DMC, USMS will also pay \$8.00 per subscription but will receive back 75% of advertising revenues and will own all rights to stories and pictures which is currently not the case. DMC assured the convention that they will be offering an expanded and livelier magazine covering our sport.

Rotating NYS Championships

The Chairs of the three NY LMSC's got together and decided to rotate the annual SCY Championships between the districts annually rather than every two years. Metro will try to host the 2006 meet at West Point, allowing Upstaters to attend without driving into the NY City area. This season's meet in Binghamton will be a two day meet similar to the recently held ESG's with a mid-day start on Sat and an early afternoon finish on Sunday allowing for only one overnight for most swimmers. The date will be set in the next issue of the WPG.

Exercise Pays

Lastly, ever wonder if swimming is worth the effort? At this past SCY Nationals held in Indianapolis, Dr. Joel Stager of Indiana University tested 200 swimmers at the meet. While the results cannot be published due to the method of collection, the findings were very noteworthy. As the age groups got older, the difference between masters swimmers and "normal people" became larger and larger. The masters did much better in all area such as body mass indexes, aerobic capacity, strength, cholesterol levels, and much more. The Sports Medicine Committee has recommended to finance Dr. Stager to continue his research so it can be published in the future. Fast swims to all of you. Dan

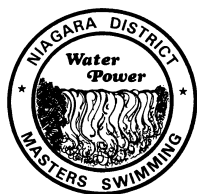

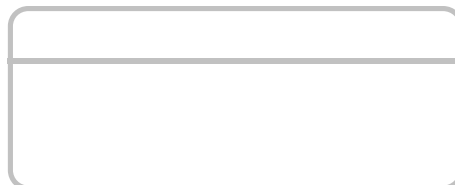
